

TYPING OF PINYIN VOWELS WITH TONAL MARKS WHEN USING UNICODE PINYIN CHARACTERS

Type the hexadecimal (HEX) number followed by {Alt+X} or hold down the {Alt} key and type the decimal number (DEC) on the numeric keypad (with NUM LOCK on).

- The Pīnyīn characters were typed using macros written by Jasper Burford in Word on 7 September, 2017
- Curly brackets {} enclose keys that must be pressed at the same time.
- The key “A” produces a small “a”; “{Shift+A}” produces a capital “A”; {Ctrl+1}, {Shift+A} produces “Ā”.

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
